Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner provided the time limit for the judge has not been reached. The request must be made to the Trial Secretary no later than noon, Monday, October 16, 2022, to be included in the Judging Schedule/catalog. Dogs qualifying for a title on October 20 and 21, may be transferred to a higher class for the following trials provided the request is made to the Trial Secretary in writing at the trial site by 5pm the day prior to the move-up date and provided that the time limit for the judges has not been reached.

Turn slight left onto 39th Street. Turn left onto Main Avenue. Go 4 blocks and turn right onto Jefferson Blvd. K-9 is located on the corner of Jefferson and Main.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these events the exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all exercises safely.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites or any communicable disease and have appropriate vaccinations.
- The Calcasieu Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, theft, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- The Calcasieu Kennel Club reserves the right to substitute any award with one of equal or greater value.
- The Calcasieu Kennel Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for any of these events.
- Puppies under six months of age are prohibited from the trial grounds.

Entries:

- Checks that have been returned due to insufficient funds do not constitute a valid entry. A \$25 service fee will be added for all returned checks. Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action(s) of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be returned if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Entries must be made on official AKC entry forms or copies and must be complete, bear a valid signature, and include the AGREEMENT AND RULES. Entries with missing information will be returned.

- If entering Rally Advanced, Master or Excellent, or Obedience Open or Utility include your jump height in the appropriate box on the entry form. Catalog order in these classes will be based on jump height.
- No entries shall be made, and no entries shall be accepted, which specify any conditions as to their acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees and signatures. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by email prior to the close of entries. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of errors or cancellations of entries, after the published closing date. Fax options are no longer supported.
- The Calcasieu Kennel Club may decline entries for just cause. It may refuse to receive entries or may remove any dog on account of aggression, disease, deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No one shall have a claim or recourse against Calcasieu Kennel Club, Inc., or any official thereof.
- Should a bitch come into season before the Friday show and owner notifies the show secretary at that time (email/time date stamp) entry fees will be refunded in full. If a bitch comes into season after the start of the show, refunds will be determined on a case-by-case basis. Such bitches will be marked as "Withdrawn in Season" and no AKC fees will be paid and will not be allowed to show in any classes.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and their children. Any exhibitor whose dog or child creates unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee members, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on a leash when not in the ring.
- Exhibitors are responsible at all events for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to exhibit. Judges are not required to hold up a class for tardiness. Neither CKC nor any ring steward will be responsible for calling or notifying exhibitors that they are due in the ring.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs at the trial site and motels. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund.
- **DO NOT LEAVE ANY DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES.** If any dog seems to be suffering from extreme temperatures or is confined without supervision, the authorities will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the Trial Committee and/or the AKC for disciplinary action. All persons attending this show hereby waive any claim against the Calcasieu Kennel Club and its members, in the event a motor vehicle is entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any such claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular Variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth1 coal, long coat), English Toy Spaniels(King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs can be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are confirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are ntering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. Stale on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 1, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire AND Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
